Hillcrest LGBTQ+ Heritage Interpretive Plan

- Mechanism to Designate Properties that Have Shared Significance.
- Facilitates Historical Designation of Hillcrest's Important LGBTQ+ Resources.
- Allows Property Owners to Designate LGBTQ+ Resources with Minimal Cost and Effort.



Significant and if it Retains Historic Integrity.

- Develop in Partnership with the Community.
- Honor and Celebrate LGBTQ+ People, Events, Buildings and Sites (Existing and Lost).
- Interface with Other Planning Disciplines to Create an Urban Environment that Informs and Celebrates.





What is a Historic Context Statement?

- Provides guidance for identifying and evaluating historic buildings and sites.
- Ties important historic events and people to the built environment.



- Document based on historic perspective.
- A living document that is updated as research and understanding grows.

A Historic Context Statement is Not:

- A comprehensive history of its subject matter.
- A static document.



How is a Property Determined to be Significant?


- Evaluated against the City's 5 five designation Criteria:
 - A: Special Element of City or Community's Development
 - B: Event/Person
 - C: Architecture
 - D: Work of a Master
 - E: State or National Register
- Not all associated resources are eligible.
- Must be demonstrably important through research and comparative analysis.
 - Consider contemporary ephemera (newsletters, fliers, letters), oral history, and input from community members and stakeholders.



2016 Citywide LGBTQ Historic Context Statement

- Identified Themes: Social Life, Community Organizations, Political Activism, Religion, LGBTQ Media, and Arts & Culture
- Resources Dating to the 1970s and 1980s in Hillcrest, Pacific Beach, Ocean Beach, North Park, Golden Hill and Downtown.
- Associated Property Types:
 - Places of Social Interaction
 - Sites of Political Action & Reaction
 - Residences and Offices

- Significant LGBTQ Businesses
- Sites Associated with Institutions & Organizations





- Theme 1: LGBTQ+ Social Life in Hillcrest
 - Discusses the importance of venues that allowed LGBTQ+ people to meet, socialize, educate, and share information, particularly prior to the gay liberation movement.
 - Bars, clubs, coffee shops, bathhouses, movie theaters, etc.
 - Discussions that began in these venues evolved into the creation of dedicated community organizations and events, which contributed to the growing sense of community and solidarity.
 - Property Types:
 - Commercial and Residential
 - HRB Criteria:
 - A and/or B



- Theme 2: LGBTQ+ Community Organizations & Political Activism in Hillcrest
 - Discusses the importance of community organizations and political activism that emerged with the gay liberation movement.
 - Support and advocacy groups such as The Center and San Diego Pride
 - Political organizations such as Teddy Roosevelt Republican Club, the San Diego Democratic Club, and the Gay Activists of San Diego.
 - Medical organizations and support such as "Our House", the AIDS Assistance Fund, and Priority Pharmacy
 - Property Types:
 - Institutional, Commercial, Residential, and Sites
 - HRB Criteria:
 - A and/or B



- Theme 3: The LGBTQ+ Media in Hillcrest
 - Discusses the importance of periodicals and other media in providing information relevant to the LGBTQ+ community.
 - Newspapers, newsletters, magazines.
 - Provided a vital avenue for social networking, business advertisements, legal advice, and reporting on current events and politics.
 - Property Types:
 - Institutional, Commercial and Residential
 - HRB Criteria:
 - A



- Theme 4: LGBTQ+ Arts and Culture in Hillcrest
 - Discusses the importance of performing arts, visual arts and design, and literature as a means of of expressing tolerance for sexual diversity and as a platform for LGBTQ+ persons to tell their stories.
 - Theaters, bookstores, homes, etc.
 - Arts and culture venues served as meeting places and access points for literature, poetry, plays, and other works banned elsewhere. In addition, they helped form a communal network and facilitated political organization.
 - Property Types:
 - Commercial and Residential
 - HRB Criteria:
 - A and/or B



- Theme 5: LGBTQ+ Business and Commerce
 - Discusses the importance of LGBTQ+ owned and/or oriented businesses in fostering a sense of community and belonging, and in revitalizing the aging community.
 - Bars, clubs, restaurants, coffee shops, bookstores, bathhouses, movie theaters, etc.
 - Greater San Diego Business Association (San Diego Equality Business Association), Hillcrest Business Improvement District, and Hillcrest Business Association.
 - Property Types:
 - Commercial and Residential
 - HRB Criteria:
 - A and/or B



Next Steps

- Seeking public input and comment through end of August on:
 - Themes identified.
 - Individuals and events important to the LGBTQ+ community.
 - The location of buildings and events important to the LGBTQ+ community, particularly as they relate to the themes identified.
- Hillcrest LGBTQ+ Historic Context Statement will be updated to include:
 - Additional edits from staff.
 - Input received from the public.
 - Historic photos, maps, tables, and other illustrative exhibits.



Next Steps

- Hillcrest LGBTQ+ Historic Context Statement will be wrapped up this fall.
 - Will inform other aspects of the Historic Preservation Strategy.
- Hillcrest Potential Historic District currently under evaluation.
- Hillcrest LGBTQ+ History and Culture Interpretive Plan.
 - Kick-off late 2021-2022.
 - Involve extensive input from LGBTQ+ community and other stakeholders.
 - Opportunity to celebrate and inform without considerations related to formal historic preservation efforts.






